Position Description – Outreach Worker

Purpose of position: To support the delivery of Artsenta’s outreach programme in North Otago.

Employment status: Casual

Location: Kurow, Palmerston or Oamaru

Responsible to: The Director and/or Deputy Director of Artsenta

Functional relationships: Service users (artists), their whanau or representatives
Outreach Art Worker or Peer Support Worker
Artsenta’s Outreach Coordinator

Mission of Creative Arts Trust: “Wellbeing through creativity and community”

Tasks:

1. Assist in the delivery of the Outreach programme. This includes:
 - Helping facilitate Creative Sessions on the day required
 - Providing information to and welcoming potential attendees
 - Providing creative support to attendees
 - Helping facilitate a safe and positive creative environment
 - Assisting with the set-up and tidying of venues
2. Work under the direction of the Outreach Art Worker or Outreach Peer Support Worker as needed to ensure the smooth running and safety of the programme.
3. Support the safety of artists and staff while working including implementing emergency procedures, first aid or other measures as needed.
4. Actively manage your own personal mental wellbeing, including seeking support and communicating with colleagues if needed.
5. Liaise with Artsenta staff as needed to ensure the needs of the programme are fulfilled and any administrative issues are in order.
6. Support and work towards achieving the Creative Arts Trust’s mission.
7. Other tasks as identified by the Director or Deputy Director.
